Gen 41 v 9-15

- Father please anything that needs to move out of my life for me to be repositioned for greatness let it go now in the name of Jesus
 Father by the authority in the name of Jesus any power that has been speaking against my destiny, I silence them today in the name of
- Jesus, I command you to cease now in the name of Jesus
- $\cdot \quad \text{Father let the heavens over me be opened over me in the name of Jesus. Father open my heavens today in the name of Jesus}$
- Father I am here for you, meet with me today, let there be an encounter between me and you in the name of Jesus.

e are looking at the topic Divine Repositioning for Greatness. Gen 41 v 9-15 Joseph was repositioned for greatness from the pit, he became a slave and from slavery he became a prisoner. But things took a different turn and he movedfrom prison to presidency. I decree in the life of someone reading this message here today you will move from your present position to a higher and greater length in Jesus name.

What does it mean to be repositioned?

To change the place where someone has been, to change a brand eg Coca-Cola repositioned to make more profit. To move from one level to the other for greater achievement. For example Esther was moved from been an orphan to the house of mordecai the gateman and from the house of mordecai she was moved to the place, from the palace she has to move Vashti for her to move to become the Queen in preparation for her to deliver the Jews. I pray for you today the lord will uproot anyone that has to move for you to enter your rightful place in Jesus name. Haman needed to be hanged for Mordecai to enter his rest. I pray for you today the Lord will remove anyone that need to move for you to enter your glory in Jesus name.

Certain things had to move for Joseph to be repositioned.

Change of location. Your location matters. Joseph had to move from prison to appear in the palace before Pharaoh. Just like Esther had to move from Israel to Persia. So for anyone to be repositioned for greatness your location must change.

For anyone to be repositioned for greatness there must be a change of appearance. Joseph shaved and changed his garment. Esther was brought into the care of a caretaker who prepared them before they are allowed to see the king, Esther 2 v 8-12

For anyone to be repositioned for greatness there must be a divine remembrance. Somebody must be inspired by God to remember you. God inspired the baker and he remembered and recommended him at the palace. In the same vein God remembered Esther through hegai the king's chamberlain and it was her turn to meet the king, Esther 2 v 15

For anyone to be repositioned for greatness there must be divine favour,



Joseph found favour in the eyes of the king after interpreting the ream. For Esther she obtained favour when the king set his eyes upon her, Esther $2 v \overline{17}$.

What do we want to reposition for in terms of greatness.

Greatness means different things for different people.

The woman with the issue of blood needed to be repositioned for healing mark 5 v 25-34. Naaman was a general in the army but he needed to be repositioned from being a leper. But God had to reposition a slave girl into his house to enable him receive his healing. That is from a chronic sickness to receive healing of sound health, 2 kings 5 v 1-19. Peter's business failed but God repositioned Jesus to hold a crusade in that place place and peter was blessed and repositioned from financial crisis to blessing Luke 5 v 4b-5a. One can also be repositioned from bondage to freedom, the mad man of Gadara. Jesus repositioned himself to the graveyard and the mad man was delivered. Luke 8 v 26-39. One can also be repositioned from bareness to fruitfulness, no matter the kind of bareness whether spiritual, academic, physical, example Abraham and Sarah, Hannah at Shiloh etc.

However of all the best repositioning a child of God should always yearn for is eternal repositioning. This is the repositioning that will help

> you to constantly remain on top example Joseph. Joseph had a hope that transcended the earth. This is the greatest of all repositioning that will make children of God to consistently remain on top of their calling, careers and businesses and transcend at the end of their sojourn on earth to eternal glory to be with God. That will be our portion in Jesus name.
