rom 1999 to mid 2015, Nigerians were lucky to have these three men, Chief Olusegun Obasanjo, Alhaji Umaru Musa Yar'adua and Dr. Goodluck Ebele Jonathan, occupy the seat of the President of the country. Despite their shortcomings, they were patriotic and brought innovation into leadership of the country. Chief Obasanjo cleared our

debts, instituted series of reforms in multiple sectors, and bequeathed \$31.5 billion in CBN reserve, \$9.43 billion in the Excess Crude Account (ECA), and \$2.18 billion in federal government savings.

Alhaji Umaru Musa Yar'adua grew the reserves to its peak at \$40 billion, and took the ECA to \$22 billion. It was from this ECA that he used to stabilize the economy during global economic meltdown in 2009. Dr. Goodluck Jonathan, bequeathed Nigeria with \$28.8bn in Foreign Reserves and \$2.2bn in ECA. He also left \$5.6 billion Nigeria Liquified Natural Gas Limited dividends and over \$1 billion investments via the Nigeria Sovereign Investment Authority. At the time these three left office, inflation rate was at 9%, while the country experienced economic growth. According to World Bank report, "Nigeria's economy experienced broad-based and sustained growth of over 7% annually on average" between the period of 2000 and 2014 when these gentlemen were in office. Nigeria was doing well generally, but Nigerians wanted more. In the quest for me, opposition APC was brought into power in 2015. In sharp contrast, the successors of the three men, Muhammadu Buhari and Bola Tinubu (incumbent) have jointly taken Nigeria backwards. They plunged the country into unprecedented debt, leaving inflation rate of 25.8% (it's actually more) with its attendant economic retrogression. Moreso, our Excess Crude Account that used to read in \$billions now stand at meager \$473.7k (less than \$500k), while our beloved Naira is at 1230/\$ - a rate that is 10 times what we had under Obasanjo, 9 times what we had under Yar'adua and 8 times the rate of Dr. Goodluck Jonathan. As we step into 2024, let's not forget to pray for God to give Nigerians the grace to survive this period of tribulations of the APC administration.
