The Living Word of God

Hebrews 4:12

The Word of God is a living Word. It is the Word that encapsulate divinity, power and the wisdom of God. The Word is so powerful that it is the bedrock of creation. Without the Word the world will have continued in darkness. Let us take a look at the various dimensions of what the Word can do

God word is light (Psalm 119, Verse 105) “Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.” When light is absent, people stumble and miss their way. There will be darkness and one will be groping. But when you have the word then you will reflect the Light of God and it will shine in darkness. I pray that the light of God will brighten your path and guide you to life in Jesus' name.

In the book of John 17,17: The Word of God says “Sanctify them through thy truth, thy word is truth.” When you want to know the truth about anything, search through the scriptures. When you want to know the truth about your health, don't keep staring at a medical report. Instead, focus on God's word and believe in what he said in his word concerning your health. For example, the book of 2 Peter 2 verse 24 says that by his stripes you were healed. This is a settled matter. And regardless of what any report says, good health and healing is the truth about you. When you want to know the truth about your finances, read through God's word, not the economic report or forecast. Economists can say whatever they want to say, but you must choose to believe the word of the Lord. God's word contains the truth about everything that concerns you as His child. We as His children are not moved by sight or what we see. We are moved the Word of God, that is what the word says concerning you and me. We as His children are not moved by what the world says but rather we are moved by what His Word says. We as His children are not moved by emotions or what we feel but rather we are moved by our faith and trust in Him. A child of God is not moved by his emotions or what is happening around him or her. It is what the Word says that matters to us because His word never lies, it is yea and amen. (John 5 verse 63)

God's word is also life. If anything in your life or around you is dead, God's word can bring it back to life. By his word, Peter's dead business reached a net-breaking, boat-sinking revival. Luke 5 verse 1-7. By his word, the dead son of the widow of Nain jumped

back to life (Luke 7 verse 11-15).

God's word is alive. According to our text, his word is living, active, and sharper than any two-edged sword. Our text today reveals that the word of God reveals things that are ordinarily not easy to see or understand. There is nothing hidden under the sun that God cannot unveil. (Hebrews 4 verse 13). Apart from unveiling the things that are hidden, God's word brings peace amidst storms. When Jesus and his disciples were trying to cross the other side of the sea, they did not expect that they would be caught in the middle of a storm. The storm came, and the disciples thought they would die. They began to panic, but thankfully Jesus was on the boat, and his word calmed the storm.

The word of God is spirit. John 6 verse 63: “The word that I speak to you, they are spirit and they are life. The spirit alone gives eternal life. Human effort accomplish nothing.” In other words, the word of God carries life because they are spirits and have capacity to create and bring to bear. The word is so powerful that it can pierce through any medium and deliver result.

The Word of God transforms. In the book of John 1v12, it is said that those who believe his word, he gave them power to be sons of God. Jesus gave the power or authority to those who believe in the word of God to become the children of God. This power is the spiritual antibody and the right to be adopted into the godly family enabled by believing in Jesus and his name.

Beloved, God's word contains all that you need in life. All you have to do is stand by it, believe it, meditate on it, and apply it in your daily work. Jesus is the word. Do you believe in the word? Have you accepted Jesus into your life? Bow your head and talk to him now. As Him for mercy. Tell Him that you are ready to submit your life to Him now. Promise that henceforth you will strive to serve and obey Him. As long as you are sincere in your desire for mercy He will show you mercy and your life will never be the same again.
